RE:- Room reallocations Tweed Heads Community Health Centre

I write in relation to the progression of room reallocations at Tweed Heads Community Health Centre.

Northern NSW Local Health District (NNSWLHD) has determined that due to space limitations in all departments across the Tweed Hospital campus, a campus wide approach will be taken to review clinic room and office allocation and utilisation. In addition to this, the NNSWLHD will create additional space through the installation of a demountable pod on site.

Therefore, current plans and proposals for room reallocations in the Allan Millard room within Tweed Heads Community Health Centre have been placed on hold and will be reconsidered as part of the larger campus wide strategy. In the interim, small room changes may be required as temporary measures to ensure service continuity.

The NNSWLHD will establish a formal consultation process with all relevant industrial bodies in regards to this matter.
