

# NNSWLHD Community Health Review Update

Dear Member,

We would like to be sending you an email with more detail and answers on the Community Health Review, but unfortunately we can't.

Why?

Because the LHD has not bothered to respond to issues raised with them in writing, as they said they would after the meeting on Wednesday 16 October.

The LHD agreed that they would get back to the HSU with the more details on the following:

- How the streaming will operate
- What is happening with the IVAN review
- The state election promise of 48 allied health staff
- The timeframes for populating the structure
- Role of admin support
- What happens to the clinical hours of managers?
- Where do Allied Health Assistants fit?
- A list of affected employees as the structure currently stands.

The LHD also asked that the HSU agree to the role of General Manager being advertised so it can be filled by December. If the HSU agrees to this proposal, it will allow the new General Manager essentially to project manage the review as soon as they are employed.

However, we won't agree to this until they answer the questions HSU members have asked us to raise.
