

HSU takes Sylvanvale to the Fair Work Commission

Dear Member,

As many of you are aware, Health Services Union members have been strongly opposed to Sylvanvale management's plans to install CCTV cameras in staff sleepover areas.

This is a violation of your privacy.

HSU members have been actively campaigning against such plans. The HSU has raised multiple potential disputes in relation to the *Workplace Surveillance Act 2005 (NSW)* with management.

It is extremely disappointing that senior management are determined to install CCTV cameras in staff sleepover areas and further areas that violate the privacy and workplace wellbeing of HSU members.

Today the HSU has lodged a dispute with the Fair Work Commission. Sylvanvale management have now been told in no uncertain terms our strong opposition towards the installation of CCTV cameras in staff sleepover areas and the lack of good faith demonstrated by senior management in their consultation with HSU members.
