Clinical Services Plan (CSP) consultation process

I am writing to provide you further information on the development of Canberra Health Service's Clinical Services Plan (CSP). Further to the presentation at the Union Forum by Deputy CEO Dave Peffer (10 October 2019), we have now commenced the CSP development process.

The CSP is a high level plan to guide the provision of future clinical services within a time horizon of 2020-2030. It will support our planning processes for infrastructure as well as our future workforce.

Development of the CSP is a joint initiative between the ACT Health Directorate and Canberra Health Services, and will be led by an external consultant. The consultation process will include 55 group sessions with over 820 clinical staff members, consumers, Non-Government Organisations and unions.

We will seek your views on the first draft of the CSP, as soon as it is prepared.

Canberra Health Services and the consultant has commenced meeting with team members and is working towards having a draft CSP ready for your review early 2020.
