

New zone structure for Public Health

Dear Member,

Our union has recently implemented a new zone structure for Public Health across NSW and the ACT. This new structure will mean an enhancement in resources, management and outcomes.

Because our union is growing, we are in a position to put more back into frontline resources.

From Jan 1 2020 there will be smaller areas for organisers to facilitate more visits to worksites and more assistance for campaign action from members. There will also be a dedicated Manager for Regional Areas and a dedicated manager for the Sydney Metro Area.

For most members and delegates, your organiser will not change. However, some of you will have a new organiser. This is because we are putting on additional staff and management resources.

For those of you getting a new organiser, your organiser or the relevant zone manager will be in touch to facilitate a handover. The transition will not leave any gaps in coverage and you will continue to have someone ready to help organise and resolve issues as required. There are two vacant positions which will be recruited to in the new year. Until those positions are filled your existing organiser will cover that area.
