The HSU car park campaign continues following our launch on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019. Thank you to all the members and staff who have collected, and continue to collect, signatures on our petition for free parking to stay at Campbelltown Hospital.

This matter has also been raised by the Member for Campbelltown, Greg Warren MP, in NSW Parliament. We will continue to shine a light on this new backdoor tax on health workers – see Channel 9 story on Tuesday night this week [LINK HERE](#).

Our HSU Organisers from the campaign team will be on site on **Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup> of December** to push this matter forward and keep up the momentum with petitions. Petitions can be used at front desks and counters for community members. Every conversation is vital!

We have new posters to put around the Hospital, and Organisers will also be collecting any signed petitions.

Members should be proud of your efforts so far, but the fight is far from over. Rest assured that we will continue to campaign against the proposed \$23.60 per week parking fees. Taxpayers have already paid for this car park worth over \$30M, so why are workers being asked to pay again?
