

Further update regarding members concerns

Following on from our recent newsletter regarding your concerns, HSU has received further correspondence which is in italics below for your reference:

Further to last week's correspondence, we continue to work with staff regarding any issues or concerns they raise regarding the new spaces and workflows.

We still have 2 stages of the build (which will happen together) to be completed, noting that some rooms raised below are still in the final stages of completion/construction and are not yet handed over for utilisation.

We are committed to working with the staff as we work through the build and transition process as it will require temporary changes as we finalise the build. Information and communication regarding these changes will occur through the Service Manager and through the HSS supervisor.

Health Share will provide further detail on the work being undertaken on the work schedules and workflows.

I hope this addresses the concerns raised.

As you can see from the information provided, it is 'business as usual' and therefore HSU advises our members to continue their previous workflow and patterns.
