Dear Mr Hayes

I write to advise you of the relocation of three Illawarra Shoalhaven Local Health District services affecting staff in positions covered by the Health Services Union (HSU) to a new site based at 100-102 Jardine Street Fairy Meadow 2519. The services are;

- Oral Health staff currently based at 33 Five Islands Road Port Kembla 2505
- RAS (Regional Assessment Service) currently based at Port Kembla Hospital
- ACAT (Aged Care Assessment Team) currently based at Bulli Hospital

Employees of RAS and ACAT impacted by this change were advised of the relocation in December 2019, and confirmed to all impacted staff (Oral Health, RAS, ACAT) on 20 January 2020. At the time of writing, a relocation date is not yet confirmed but will occur shortly after the 24 February. Once a date is confirmed, employees will be given at least four weeks written notice of the change in their accustomed place of work.

I confirm that in accordance with the consultative provisions of the applicable Awards that genuine consultation will occur with respect to the relocation.

Health Management of the three services are available to meet with local officials to discuss the proposal.
