

Australian Unity applies for a NSW compensation group self-insurer licence

Australian Unity has applied to the NSW State Insurance Regulatory Authority (SIRA) for a workers compensation self-insurer licence, covering the following wholly owned subsidiaries:

- Australian Unity Group Services Pty Ltd
- Australian Unity Better Living Services Pty Ltd
- Australian Unity Care Services Pty Ltd
- Australian Unity Home Care Service Pty Ltd
- Better Home Care Pty Ltd
- Australian Retirement Living Management Pty Ltd
- KNS Essential Care Pty Ltd

If Australian Unity's application is successful, this will mean they will manage all workers compensation claims internally.

SIRA has asked for feedback from interested stakeholders, by Friday 7 February 2020.
