

Campbelltown Mental Health Changes to Reporting Lines

Dear Member,

The HSU attended a meeting this week with affected members, management and HR from SWSLHD and HealthShare regarding changes to reporting lines for Cleaning staff, Cooks and Food Service Assistants.

The chair of the meeting indicated that Cleaning staff will remain as SWSLHD staff, but change over from Mental Health management to Campbelltown General Services management, while Cooks and Food Service Assistants will transition to HealthShare management at Campbelltown Hospital.

In addition, the following information was provided in this meeting:

- In the near future, mental health beds will increase from 66 to 126, which will obviously require a review for appropriate staffing
- General Services staff will mainly stay in their current area under General Services management
- Food Services will possibly undergo some changes but should remain in the area they currently cover in the Mental Health Unit
- Some staff will be affected, as they perform part Cleaning and part Food Services duties
- Members raised that the Birunji unit has been short 1x FTE cleaner for 11 years
- Breakfast duty will be removed from Nursing staff and go to Food Services staff
