

Private Health workers: Are you being paid correctly?

Dear Member,

Are you being underpaid? What about superannuation – are your contributions adding up correctly? Does the classification determining how you are paid accurately reflect the work that you do? Does your employer pay you overtime when you are entitled to it under your Enterprise Agreement or the Award?

The Private Health Division of the Health Services Union (HSU) wants to know if your employer is ripping you off. Wage theft is widespread across most industries, and private health is not immune. If you think that you are not being paid correctly or are not being paid superannuation, then we want to hear from you.

We know that workers in the industry – whether you're a cleaner, radiographer, phlebotomist or sterilising technician – work exceptionally hard and often go above and beyond in the course of their duties. We also know that employers will do whatever they can to avoid paying workers what they are entitled to if they can think they can get away with it.

Every cent that you earn belongs in your pocket. We want to make sure that your take-home pay contains everything you are owed.
